

How to Present Well

Don't rely on PowerPoint

- It's a visual aid, not the main event.
- Clear, simple slides with minimal text
- Don't read off slides – make notes for yourself



The main thing

- Practice makes perfect
- Don't be shy about your accent
- Speak SLOWLY
- It's ok to pause, but avoid "UM"
- Record yourself



Body language

- Avoid reading directly off your slides
- Stand up straight
- Use hands to gesture, but don't over-do it
- Make eye contact with audience



Final thoughts

- It's ok to script things
- Improvement takes time
- Ask for feedback
- Practice, practice, practice!
